## **The Zero-Emission Assurance Project**

### **What is ZAP?**

The Zero-Emission Assurance Project (ZAP), funded by the Budget Act of 2022, is designed to assist Californians who have purchased a **used** zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) or near-zero emission vehicle (NZEV) through a California Air Resources Board (CARB) incentive program and suspect that their vehicle's critical battery or fuel cell components are in need of major repair. The CARB incentive programs include the Driving Clean Assistance Program (DCAP), Clean Vehicle Assistance Program (CVAP), and Clean Cars 4 All (CC4A). ZAP complements these clean transportation initiatives by offering diagnostic and repair services for the premature failure of battery or fuel cell components.

**Who We Serve:** California residents who purchased used electric vehicles through CARB incentive programs (DCAP, CVAP, Clean Cars 4 All) and are **currently experiencing** battery degradation, fuel cell issues, or critical battery system component failures.

## What are the vehicle requirements?

This program is designed to support the diagnosis and repair of battery and fuel cell components of near zero-emission vehicles including plug-in hybrid electric vehicles (PHEV), fuel cell electric vehicles (FCEV), and battery electric vehicles (BEV).

### Vehicle Requirements

The vehicle cannot be covered under the manufacturer warranty

Coverage for 15 years after the date of manufacture or up to 200,000 miles

### Decreased Battery Storage Capacity

Below 70% of original capacity

### Decreased Fuel Cell Power Output

Not publicly known and will defer to manufacturers' threshold for replacement

### Covered System Component Failures

### Covered System Components

- Battery Pack
- Battery Management System (BMS)
- Fuel Cell

### Diagnostic Requirements

\*\*\*Vehicles must be diagnosed by a ZAP approved diagnostic location ONLY\*\*\*
